



Roselea Football Club: Codes of Conduct

Winning at any sport, once in a competitive age group, is a part of our sporting tradition but the “spirit of the game” is more important.

This good sporting spirit is an integral part of the Roselea Football Club and must be demonstrated at all times by our players, team and club officials, parents of our junior players and all of our supporters and spectators.

It is particularly important that this is demonstrated and modelled to our youngest players who learn from observing and following the role modelling of parents, coaches, managers and senior players.

At Roselea Football Club the following Codes of Conduct, are expected, and will be enforced.

COACHES AND MANAGERS CODE OF CONDUCT

Roselea FC Coaches and Managers must

- Be reasonable in your demands on players - Players play for fun and enjoyment. Don't ridicule mistakes.
- Teach players that the rules of sport should be followed, not broken
- Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all players, coaches and officials.
- Develop and ensure team respect for opponents and officials from both teams.
- Ensure that all players show respect for Referees, Assistant Referees and Other Match Officials

Abuse of referees and assistant referees will not be tolerated in any form.

Abuse includes

- Derogatory comments about the match official's performance or ability
 - Repeated or vocal criticism or challenging of the match official or their decisions
 - And any form of insulting, offensive, aggressive or intimidating behaviour or language directed at a match official.

- Treat all players the way you would like to be treated yourself.
 - Play for the “fun of it” and not just to please parents or spectators.

Parents and Spectators Code of Behaviour.

- Encourage players and accept results without disappointment.
- Never ridicule or yell at a player for making mistakes or losing the game.
- Players are involved for their enjoyment, not for their parents or spectators.
- Volunteers deserve your respect and consideration.
- Eliminate verbal and physical abuse from all sporting activities

Play by the rules

- ❖ Respect opponents. Abuse of opponents is not allowed in any sport.
- ❖ Treat all players the way you would like to be treated yourself.
- ❖ Play for the “fun of it” and not just to please parents, spectators and coaches.
- ❖ Respect the rights, dignity and worth of all players, coaches and officials.
- ❖ Accept defeat with dignity and don't seek excuses for defeat or blame the referee or anyone else
