

NWSF Player Borrowing Eligibility Matrix

Introduction

This Matrix is a guide to visually represent NWSF Regulations Section 9.6 PLAYING OUT OF GRADE (BORROWED PLAYERS), clauses 9.6.1.1 - 9.6.1.3 - 9.6.1.5 - 9.6.1.6 - 9.6.1 - 9.6.6 - 9.6.7 & 9.6.8.

How to use this Matrix.

1. You wish to borrow a player when your team is short on game day, but are not sure if they are eligible to play in your team.
2. Please only contact the NWSF office as a last resort.
3. Go to the appropriate sheet following that is relevant to your team and game (either regular season or championship/pennant finals).
4. Start in the left-hand column, indicated by the Green Arrow, , to locate **YOUR** team.
5. Work your way along the 3rd row, indicated by the Red Arrow, , to locate the team that the borrowed player comes from.
6. The cell where the row and column intersect will indicate whether they are eligible to play for you by showing a  or a .
7. If the cell shows a , they player is eligible with further conditions, usually as they are playing up more than two years.
 - a. In this case further assessment is required by your club to individual player suitability, ie Player size, stature, skill, etc.
 - b. If approved by your club, a PLAYING ABOVE AGE CONSENT FORM will be required, signed by the players parents, to be completed prior to the player taking the field.
