



Fines Policy Statement

Roselea Football Club (RFC) is a family-oriented sports club. We believe in promoting participation in our game, equal opportunity for all players, development of football and team skills, and above all, enjoyment of the game.

- North West Sydney Football may impose fines upon the club under section 14 of the NWSF Competition Regulations. Among these are
 1. Team sheet and score reporting infringements
 2. Competition Fines
 3. NWSF may impose other fines including matters related to the General Purpose Tribunal (GPT)

The Club in its Coach and Manager sessions pre-season outline the importance of NWSF regulations and provides training on I-compman for electronic team sheets and results entry. Other matters such as forfeits are also raised.

Further, the Club outlines its own Code of Conduct for Players, Coaches and Spectators, directs Coaches and managers towards the Code of Conduct for NWSF on the NWSF website.

Team sheet and score reporting infringements

Upon receipt of the first fine for each team, the team Coach and Manager will be notified by email of the breach.

The Club will pay the first fine for each team for team sheet and score reporting infringements, with all subsequent fines for that team to be reimbursed to the Club by the team.

Exceptions to the above

- Where the team has not been notified of their first breach by email from the club, the team shall be responsible for subsequent fines from the date of email notification from the club.

Competition Fines, and other NWSF fines including from the GPT

Such fines shall be passed on to the team involved unless the RFC Board determines that the team will not be required to make such payment.
